### **JERSEY SES EXPLORER AWARD – An award of £1,000 and the title of ‘Jersey SES Explorer of the Year 2020’.**

The Jersey SES Explorer Award has been created to support a Jersey person 18+ on an overseas trip to a remote area where they will lead a project of their choice either with a focus on photography, filmmaking, scientific research or medical aid. The project must either:

- Through photography/filmmaking: Bring attention and support to the needs of indigenous people living in a remote area and/or the plight of fauna and flora.

or

- Combine scientific adventure in challenging environments to benefit communities or the environment in underdeveloped regions of the world.

All candidates will be expected to provide updates of their project both in planning and delivery. The candidates must also provide a final report presented at a Jersey SES event on their return along with either film, photography or research paper or evidence of legacy.

- A cover letter and personal history CV.
- Provide an outline of the expedition.
- Purpose of the expedition and desired outcomes.
- Detail any collaboration with other organisations teams, third party references and support.

The deadline for application is 1 May 2020 and the successful applicant will be notified by 1 June 2020.
